Plans for the next Missouri Department Convention are underway with the date of June 2, 2018. The place has not been selected, but it will be in the Macon/Kirksville area.


Our 2018 National President is Caron Cleveland from New York. Sarah Meyers is the new Senior Vice President from Georgia.










Tent #16 also will join the AmVets at 360 Brown Road in St. Peters, MO in a Flag Retirement Ceremony on September 16 at 6 pm.

# 127<sup>th</sup> National Convention of the Daughters of Union Veterans of the Civil War, 1861-1865

The 127<sup>th</sup> National Convention of the Daughters of Union Veterans of the Civil War, 1861-1865 was held at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Grand Rapids, Michigan from July 26, 2017 through July 30, 2017. Six Missouri Daughters were in attendance with Rebecca Konersmann and Dianne Scheffing serving as Co-Chiefs of Staff. National President Jan Rynerson, from Indiana, presided over all official business functions.

The Grand Opening on Wednesday evening was followed by reception hosted by the Department of Michigan. Thursday morning was the Public Opening of the Convention followed by the First Official Business Session. Thursday afternoon was devoted to workshops, presentations and committee meetings followed by Business Session II. The Memory Banquet was held on Thursday evening.

Business Session III, on Friday morning included the 1<sup>st</sup> round of nominations for National Officers and invitations to "Department Open Houses" to be held later that evening. Friday afternoon was spent touring. Missouri Daughters toured the Gerald R Ford Presidential Museum on that afternoon as well.

Saturday opened with Business Session IV which included the Final Credentials Report and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Nomination of National Officers. The Official Election Balloting was held and Business Session V resumed with final Officer Reports on Saturday afternoon. Saturday concluded with the All States Banquet.

Business session VI opened on Sunday morning after the Granddaughters Breakfast, Worship Service and Memorial Service. The Report of Tellers was the biggest item on the agenda since two offices were contested. Susan Zimmer defeated Bethany Hoover for Chaplain easily. The National Treasurer contest found incumbent Susan Nitzel defeating Past Treasurer and Past National President Barbara Stone by only 4 votes.

Also from the officer reports it should be noted that <u>Tent and Department Treasurers are no longer to fill out the IRS forms</u>. That is now being done by our CPA at the National Level based on our reports to National.

Plans are already underway for the next National Convention to be held at the Airport Crowne Plaza in Minneapolis, MN, July 25-30, 2018. Newly installed National President Caren Cleaveland from New York will preside.
